

# **High School Partnerships**

On a creative pathway but not ready to leave school yet?

Extend your creative skills and earn extra credits towards NCEA through our part-time courses in Graphics, Fashion or Animation Design.

The Design School offers secondary school students part-time courses to study design in a commercial style studio while they continue with other subjects they love at school.

Our part-time courses span upto 30 weeks per year, one or two days per week. It is a standard 9-3 school day, just focused on design.

Trades Academy options are delivered in partnership with Te Pukenga-UCOL in Palmerston North. STAR options are available in collaboration with any school and we also partner with Te Kura Te Aho o Te Kura Pounamu (The Correspondence School) and Regional Health Schools.


